Participating venues include: the Cincinnati Art Museum, the Contemporary Arts Center, the Taft Museum of Art, the National Underground Railroad Freedom Center, the Cincinnati Museum Center, and other institutional partners such as Northern Kentucky University, Ohio University's Kennedy Museum, the University of Cincinnati, Miami University, the Weston Art Gallery, the Carnegie Arts Center, the Mercantile Library, the Architectural Foundation of Cincinnati, the Art Academy of Cincinnati, as well as Carl Solway Gallery, Prairie, and the Carnegie Visual and Performing Arts Center, among others.
