As the name indicates, FotoFocus concentrates on the photographic medium. 2012 marked the launch of the month-long event conceived to nurture the region's growing art scene as well as to take part in the international dialogue on contemporary photography and film. In a two-year rotation, it transforms the city of Cincinnati, Ohio, into a single large stage for photography and lens-based art.

Fans, private collectors and professionals from across the world pour into the biennial venues and indulge in the numerous exhibitions, performances, screenings, lectures and talks. While the event's core is centred in and around the imposing Beaux-Arts architecture of Memorial Hall in the heart of the city's revitalised arts district of Over-the-Rhine, various local galleries and museums, for example the Taft Museum, enlarge the programme by hosting on-topic presentations.
