

## Documentary by Cincinnati photographer debuts as part of FotoFocus 2018

As a monthlong photography exhibition gets underway across Greater Cincinnati, a new documentary explores the influences that led a local photographer to her career.

FotoFocus Biennial 2018 is a monthlong international exhibition that encompasses 90 projects featuring more than 400 artists, curators and educators – the largest of its kind in North America. In conjunction with the event, Cincinnati photographer <u>Ann Segal</u>has produced a documentary about her experiences in "Through the Lens of Time." The film is the third such work Segal has produced for FotoFocus since 2012 that explores the careers of well-known Cincinnati image makers.
